#### CONSTITUTIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Article 10.10 of the MSU Constitution sets out the constitutional responsibilities of the MSU Arts, Celtic Studies, and Philosophy Faculty Convenor. I have outlined my constitutional responsibilities below and have commented on my progress in fulfilling them.

List of Constitutional Responsibility:

- 1. The Faculty Convenors shall be the primary means of communication between the students and student academic representatives in their faculty and the Executive. In particular the Faculty Convenors shall be responsible for raising awareness of issues specific to their respective faculties in all appropriate for aincluding the Student Senate and Executive meetings.
  - I have been using the ACSP WhatsApp group chat to communicate with Academic Reps and have also sent out emails.
  - Since the last report no academic issues have been brought to my attention.
- 2. They shall be responsible for the recruitment of Student Academic Representatives within their own faculty.
  - I attended a First Year Theology class, to make a lecture announcement encouraging anyone who would be interested to contact me to sign up for this role.
- 3. Each Faculty Convenor shall arrange for a Faculty Assembly meetings to occur in their respective faculties normally six times per academic year, normally with three meetings per semester.

- The second Arts, Celtic Studies and Philosophy Faculty Assembly occurred on the 17<sup>th</sup> of November.
- The third Arts, Celtic Studies, and Philosophy Faculty Assembly will take place on the 6<sup>th</sup> of December.
- 4. Each Faculty Convenor shall arrange for a Faculty Assembly meetings to occur in their respective faculties normally six times per academic year, normally with three meetings per semester.
  - I chaired the second Arts, Celtic Studies, and Philosophy Faculty
     Assembly on Thursday the 17<sup>th</sup> at 4pm.
- 5. They shall, where practicable, undergo training during the summer months as organised by the Union.
  - I attended the crossover training prior to the term starting.

Encourage and promote the use of Gaeilge in Maynooth University and SPPU/ Déan úsáid as nathanna simplí I gcruithnithe.

I am still working on my Gaeilge via Duolingo.

Assist and aid the VP Education in campaigns and events based around education throughout the year.

 I have not assisted the VP Education during this term of work in planning campaigns but hope to help with the up-coming de-stress campaign in January as much as I can whilst doing my final year exams.

Assist and aid my academic reps and fellow faculty members with any problems arising in their respective subjects.

- Academic Reps have not come to me in this term of work with any problems arising in their respective subjects.

Assist and bring forth any ideas I have for potential events in the union.
