List of Constitutional Responsibility:

1. The Faculty Convenors shall be the primary means of communication between the students and student academic representatives in their faculty and the Executive. In particular, the Faculty Convenors shall be responsible for raising awareness of issues specific to their respective faculties in all appropriate fora including the Student Senate and Executive meetings.

I continue to be available for both reps and students. As always my email is open if there are any issues that arise.

I continue to assist reps with any academic issues and support them in any way that I can.

2. They shall be responsible for organising the election of the Student Academic Representatives for the constituencies within their faculties.

3. Each Faculty Convenor shall arrange for a Faculty Assembly meeting to occur in their respective faculties normally six times per academic year, normally with three meetings per semester.

The Social Sciences Faculty Assembly met on November 21st at 4pm in MSU and via MS Teams.

The next meeting of the Social Sciences Faculty Assembly will be on Friday, 9th December in MSU and MS Teams.

4. The Faculty Convenor shall be the Chairperson of their respective Faculty Assemblies.

I continue to chair meetings of the Social Sciences Faculty. I chaired the previous meeting of the Social Sciences Faculty Assembly on November 21st.

5. They shall, where practicable, undergo training during the summer months as organised by the Union.
