

## Summary of Proposed Changes to the Maynooth Students' Union Constitution

- **Removed** | *The Clubs Council and all its subsidiary bodies.*
- **Removed** | *The Societies Council and all its subsidiary bodies.*
- **Removed** | *The Welfare & Equality Forum and all its subsidiary bodies.*
- **Removed** | *The Part-time officers of the Executive from the Articles of the Constitution to the Schedules of the Constitution allowing for the roles to be changed without needing a referendum.*
- **Added** | *An expansion to the powers and competencies of the Electoral Commission.*
- **Added** | *The PTO position of Environmental Officer.*
- **Added** | *The PTO position of Equality Officer.*
- **Added** | *Appendices of the MSU Constitution that allows for representative bodies to have more control over their business.*
- **Added** | *An expansion and restructuring of the Union's policy structure.*
- **Added** | *A restructuring of the system of the competencies of representative bodies in the Union.*
- **Added** | *A system by which committees, sub-committees, councils, assemblies, forums, boards, and senates all have one term to describe them without using the previously mentioned specific terms: 'Representative Body'.*
- **Added** | *The Articles of the Constitution may be amended by the Student Senate for a one-year period after the certification of the proposed Constitution.*
- **Added** | *Provisions for the filling of vacant seats in the Executive, Student Senate, and Academic Assembly.*
- **Added** | *The position of LGBT+ Senator amended to LGBTQ+ Senator.*

- **Added** | *The position of St. Patrick's College Maynooth (SPCM) Senator amended to St. Patrick's Pontifical University (SPPU) Senator.*
