That 17 November is recognised as International Day of Students. The 17 November is chosen as this day to commemorate the brutal killing of nine students and lecturers in Prague as they protested the occupation of their country by the Nazi Régime.

Student Senate further recognises:

That Student Unions around the world commemorate this day and hold a minute of silence for those who lost their lives in these protests.

Student Senate therefore mandates:

That the MSU President shall propose that a minute of silence be held in commemoration of those killed during these protests at the sitting held closest to International Students' Day (17 November) and as an act of solidarity with other Students' Unions across the globe.
