## Déan é... as Gaeilge

## **Background:**

At the 6<sup>th</sup> Sitting of the 5<sup>th</sup> Session of the MSU Student Senate, the motion 'Creation and Circulation of a list of Irish Language Phrases to the MSU Student Senate' mandated:

- 1. The Oifigeach na Gaeilge to compile a list of basic Irish phrases that can be used by relevant bodies. Phrases must include but are not limited to basic Irish that can be used in social situations, formal meeting language, phrases to support the use of some Irish in e-mails or other official correspondences.
- 2. These phrases to be supplemented by at least one of the following: written phonetics, audio files, videos, or any other appropriate form of media that would support members of the MSU Senate in their pronunciation of the phrases, should they wish to use them.
- **3.** The Oifigeach na Gaeilge to submit a list of these phrases to Members of the Senate in the Irish Language as an item for note in the first and fourth sittings of the Senate.

The attached document is fulfilling the mandate above, this document has been worked on by the previous Executive and reviewed by the current Oifigeach na Gaeilge.

That the MSU Student Senate note the attached document of MSU Irish Language Phrases, named 'Déan é... as Gaeilge'.
