 many representatives during this term of work. I plan to reach out to any
 departments with no Academic Representatives and ask them to
 encourage students to sign up.

- 3. Each Faculty Convenor shall arrange for a Faculty Assembly meetings to occur in their respective faculties normally six times per academic year, normally with three meetings per semester.
 - The second Arts, Celtic Studies, and Philosophy Faculty Assembly will take place Thursday the 17th at 4pm.
- 4. Each Faculty Convenor shall arrange for a Faculty Assembly meetings to occur in their respective faculties normally six times per academic year, normally with three meetings per semester.
 - I will be chairing the second Arts, Celtic Studies, and Philosophy Faculty
 Assembly on Thursday the 17th at 4pm.
- 5. They shall, where practicable, undergo training during the summer months as organised by the Union.
 - I attended the crossover training prior to the term starting.

Connect with reps by using the group chat by informing them on events happening within the union and inform them on how they can get involved.

As mentioned, I let my reps know about Head Space and told them about the
 Speed Friending event that is happening 14th – 18th of November.

Continue the connection between SPPU and Maynooth Students ensuring all students feel represented within the union.

I hope to work on this by having all Theology reps elected by making a lecture announcement to the year group with no elected reps. I also aim to meet with Theology reps to see what can be done to ensure they feel represented.

Inform students and academic reps of the services available to them on campus.

I plan to curate a list of the services and send them to Academic Reps who
 will be able to pass it on to their classmates.

Inform and guide students and academic reps when looking into Erasmus and placement opportunities.

- I hope to chat to anyone I know who are on Erasmus/ Placement or did these and get their information on the application process and their experiences.
- With the information I will relay it to 2nd year Academic Reps so they can give information back to their classmates.

Inform and update students when elections are running and what positions are available – in by-elections and academic rep elections.

Inform students who their reps are by sharing it on socials and having the list regularly updated on the MSU website.
